

Napa Community Garden Rules

Mission: Provide opportunities for all in our community to grow organic plants and vegetables.

Garden Plots and Plantings

- I will use only non-synthetic fertilizers and organic herbicides and pesticides.
- I will keep weeds at a minimum and maintain the areas surrounding my plot.
- I promise to water my plot using water conservation principles.
- I will plant tall crops where they will not shade neighboring plots.
- I will not plant any plant that is known to be an aggressive invader in natural areas [example: fennel].
- I will not allow plants to sprawl into the paths or climb adjacent fences.

Safety and Personal Conduct

- Any pets I bring into the garden will be leashed.
- I will participate in spring and fall clean-ups, and membership meetings.
- I promise to take only reasonable amounts of fruit from the garden's trees and will take only what I can use.
- I will not plant any illegal plants. I will not smoke, use illegal drugs, nor will I come to the garden while under the influence of illegal drugs.
- I understand that there are no bathroom or trash facilities available

City of Napa Requirements

- At times when the Church parking lot is in use, I will park on the street
- Hours of operation shall be sunrise to sunset; no exterior lighting shall be used
- No motorized equipment before 7:00 am or after 7:00 pm
- I will clean tools in a manner and location to avoid polluted water entering the storm drain
- The garden shall be kept in a neat and orderly manner at all times.

I will work to keep the garden a happy, secure, and enjoyable place where all participants can garden and socialize peacefully in a neighborly manner!
